1751 Mecklenburg Census Index Book Information

This index was written in 1982 by Franz Schubert.
Göttingen 1982

The Duke of Mecklenburg ordered Pastors to submit Registers of their communicant members in 1751. 190 churches listed their confessing members. The original handwritten reports are in the State Archives in Schwerin, and the transcriptions of the records are printed in the eleven books by Franz Schubert. The reports show occupation, names of all individuals in the household 14-15 years or older, and their relationship to the family. The Salt Lake FHC has these books as well as some big university libraries (like Harvard) or other genealogical libraries.
